



FUNBox

Effective June 16, 2017, the current Initiate and Junior A categories will be combined into one and called FUNBox.

FUNBox bouts are intended to enhance young boxers' skill development in a controlled, positive, educational and fun environment. These bouts will be contested at 3 X 1 minute and 3 X 1.5 minute rounds (depending on age). FUNBox bouts are mandatory for all boxers between the ages of 6 to 12 years.

Rules:

- A FUNBox cannot have more than 20 fights.
- Coaches are not permitted to coach from the corners.
- Competitive heavy blows are discouraged. Both the referees and coaches have a responsibility to discourage heavy blows.
- FUNBox bouts will not be judged. Both boxers will be declared winners both in the ring and in their boxing Passports.
- The referee will control the bout from inside the ring and will provide instruction to the athletes.
- FUNBox bouts can be part of any show or tournament but these bouts should take place at the beginning of the show, prior to judged bouts.
- The Maximum weight difference allowance is 3kg
- The Maximum number of bouts difference is 10.
- The Maximum age difference is 12 months.
