NCCP Certification Process – Competition Introduction

- You should already have a profile and NCCP number.
- You can monitor your profile and credits on the Coach.ca webpage, www.coach.ca;
- If not already registered, register as a Coach with Boxing BC and provide a criminal record check.
- Take the in classroom Boxing Specific Competition Introduction Coaching Module hosted by Boxing BC;
- Sign up for the Competition Introduction Multisport modules on the ViaSport website, www.viasport.ca.
- These Multisport modules are:
 - o Teaching and Learning
 - o Basic Mental Skills
 - o Design a Basic Sport Program
- Apply to Boxing Canada for Evaluation and Certification as a Competition Introduction Coach. [Coach Evaluation Request Form](#).

Note*

- To keep your coaching status active, Competition Introduction Coaches need to maintain 20 Professional Development points, every 5 years.
 - o Example: further education via NCCP courses, Boxing Canada or Boxing BC approved educational initiatives
