- If not already registered, register as a Coach with Boxing BC and provide a criminal record check.
- Take the in classroom Boxing Specific Instruction Beginner Coaching Module hosted by Boxing BC;
- Sign up for the Instruction Beginner Coach Multisport modules on the ViaSport website, www.viasport.ca.
- These multisport modules are:
 - o Making Ethical Decisions
 - o Nutrition
 - o Planning a Practice
 - o Making Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation;
- Mentor under a Competition Instruction Level coach for 1 year;
- Apply to Boxing Canada for Evaluation and Certification as an Instruction Beginner Level Coach. [Coach Evaluation Request Form](#).

Note*

- To keep your coaching status active, Competition Introduction Coaches need to maintain 10 Professional Development points, every 5 years.
 - o Example: further education via NCCP courses, Boxing Canada or Boxing BC approved educational initiatives
